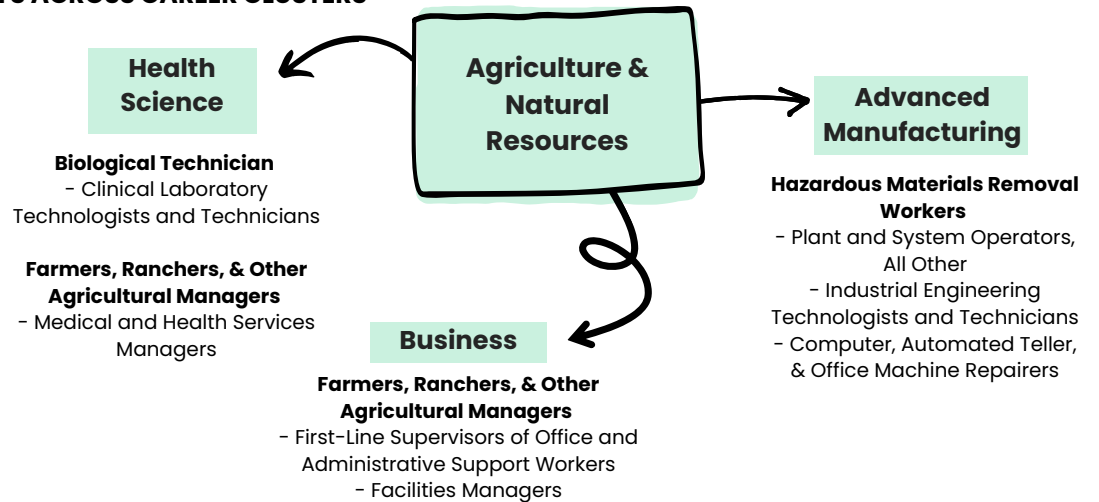


Where Aptitude Meets Interest

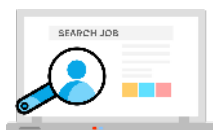
