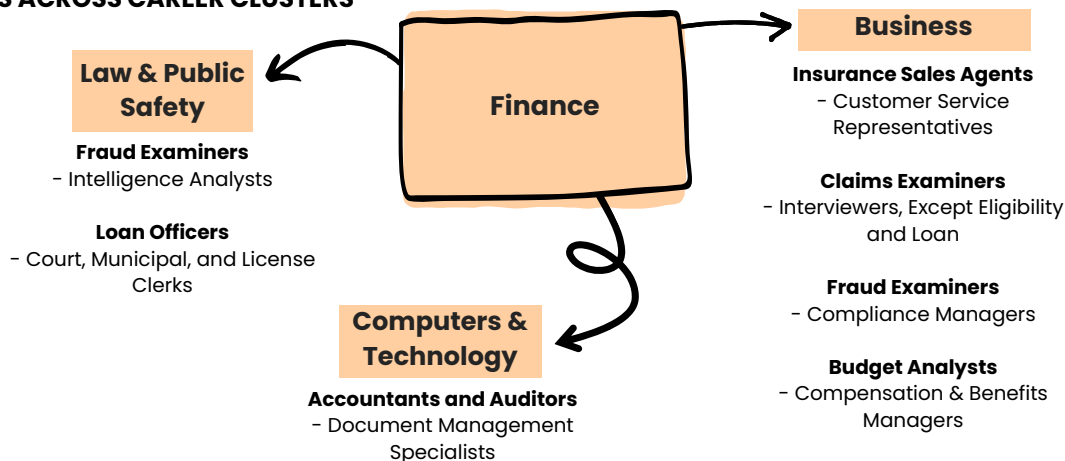


Where Aptitude Meets Interest

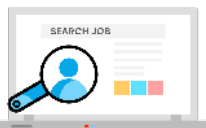

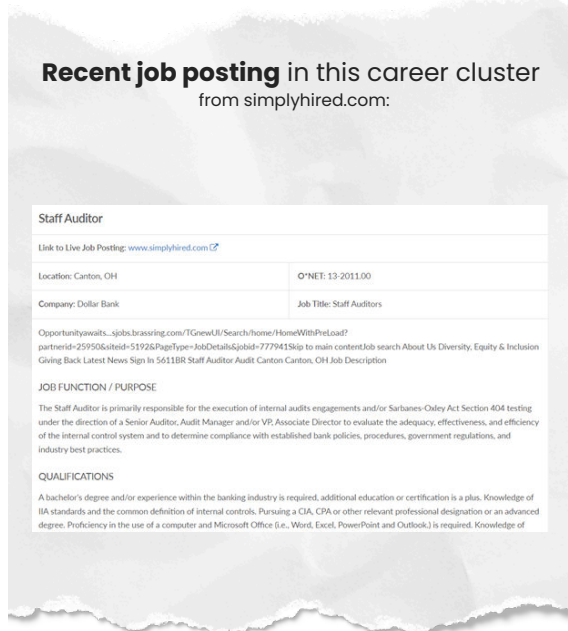
WHAT TO LOOK FOR & WHERE
