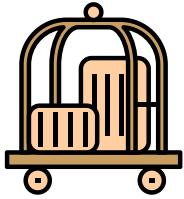

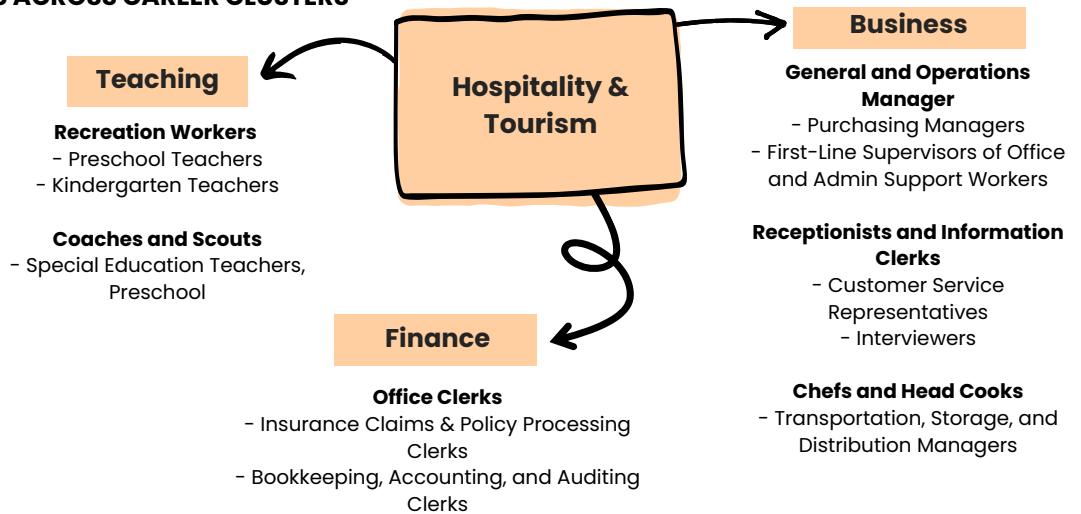


Where Aptitude Meets Interest

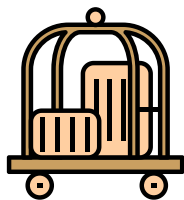
SKILLS-BASED PATHWAYS ACROSS CAREER CLUSTERS

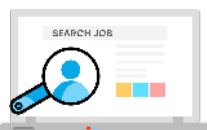

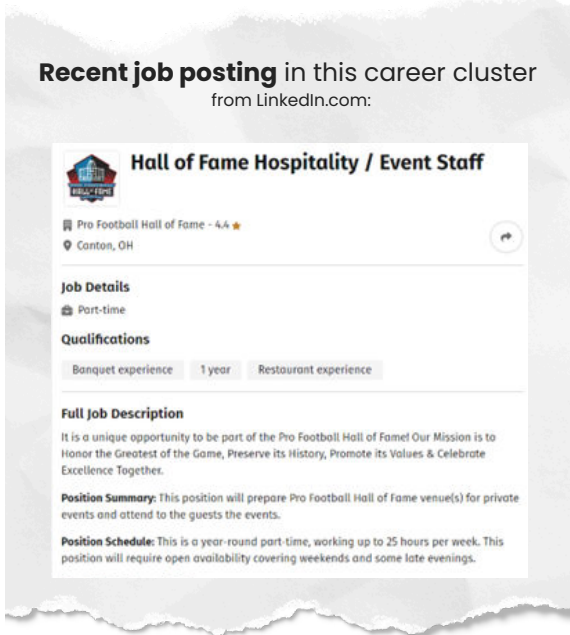
WHAT TO LOOK FOR & WHERE
